

**TCNAZ Procedures**  
**November 19, 2020**

Greetings!

I wanted to take this opportunity to update everyone on our procedures for gathering for worship, and our schedule for the next several weeks. If you have any questions about any of this, please don't hesitate to contact Pastor Rick.

First, beginning this Sunday, November 22, masks will be required for everyone who is attending worship. Although worship gatherings are exempt from the latest order prohibiting non-residential gatherings, I do not believe that we are exempt from the mandate to wear masks. The wearing of a mask, or not wearing a mask, is not a political issue; it is an issue of demonstrating that we love and value our neighbors.

Second, on Sundays November 29 and December 6, Pastor Rick will be out of town. He will be streaming the worship services on those Sundays, and he will not be at TCNAZ. However, the church will be open and the stream of the worship service will be shown on the screen for those who do not have internet service, or who prefer to gather and watch it at the church. On December 13, Pastor Rick will be back, and we'll return to in-person worship. The 10:30 worship service will still be streamed on our Facebook page.

Third, beginning on Sunday November 29, there will be no 9:00 a.m. worship service until after the first of the year. We will resume the 9:00 a.m. service on Sunday, January 3, 2021.

Finally, although this isn't directly related to our worship services, our Zoom Bible study groups on Monday and Thursday evenings will be on break after Thanksgiving. The Thursday night group's last meeting will be on November 19, and the Monday night group's last meeting was on November 16. Both groups will resume in January. The Monday night group will continue to be a follow-up to the message from the day before, and the Thursday night group will begin a new study in January. More information will be posted in regard to the Thursday night group in mid-December.
